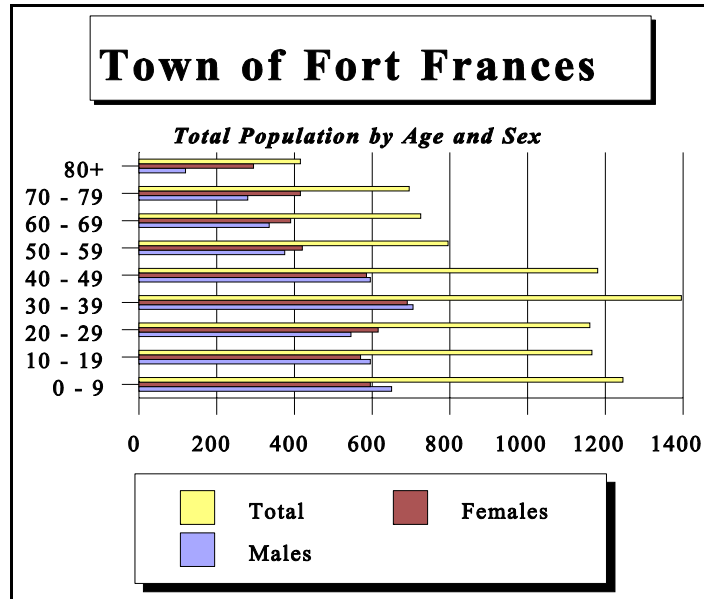

The total population of the Town of Fort Frances is currently 8,315. The total population of the Rainy River District is 17,130 not including Atikokan.

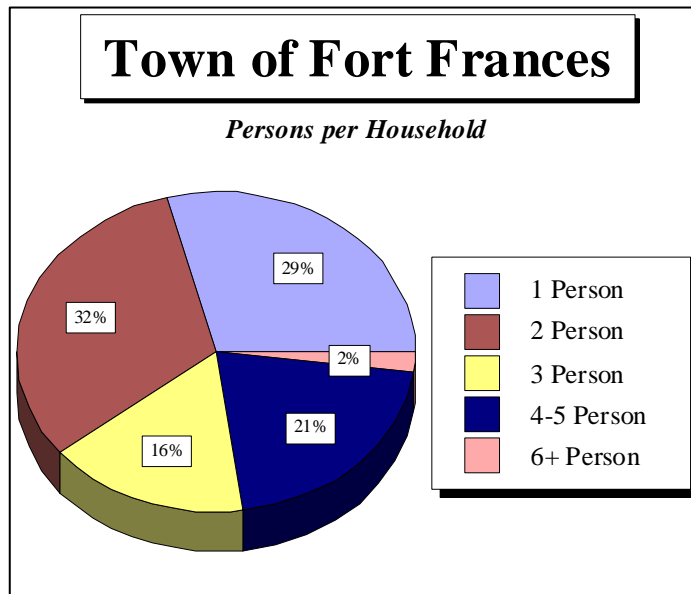


Persons per Household

Private Household: Refers to a person or a group of people (other than foreign residents) who occupy a dwelling and do not have a usual place of residence elsewhere in Canada.

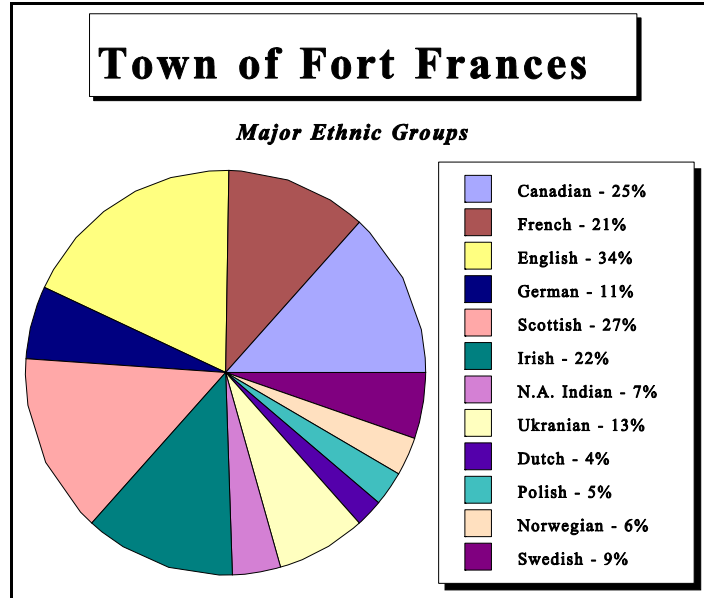
Household Size: Refers to the number of persons in a private household.

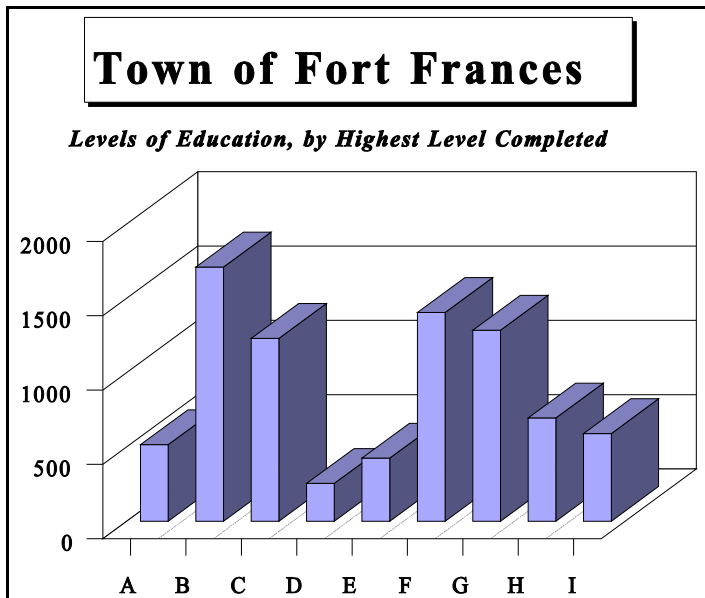

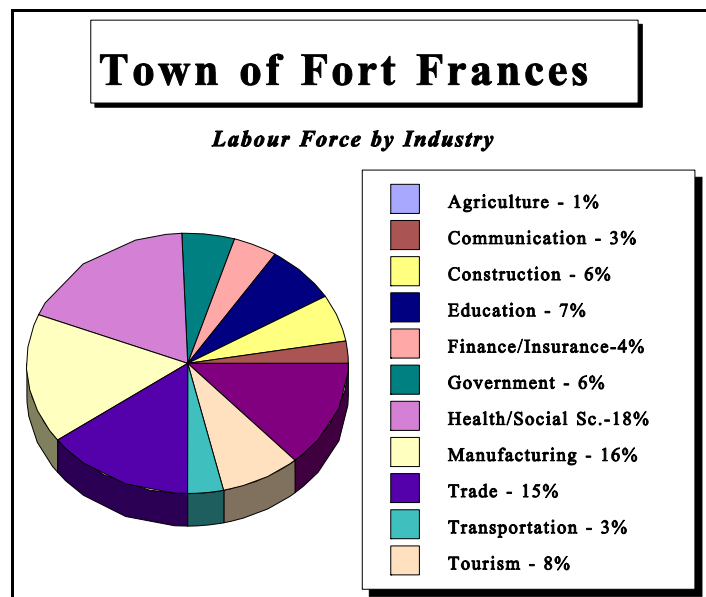

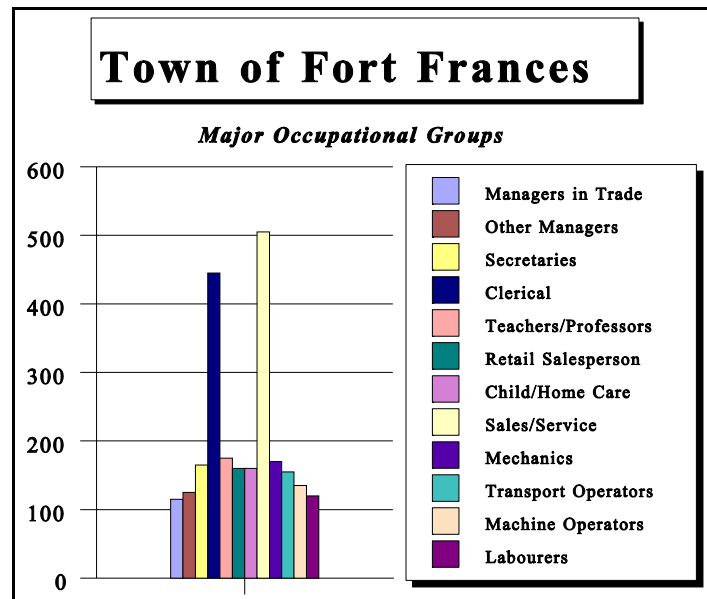
